About the Northern Powergrid Foundation:

'The Northern Powergrid Foundation was established in 2022 to support communities in the Northern Powergrid region.

Initially funded by a £7.5million donation from Northern Powergrid (North East) plc and Northern Powergrid (Yorkshire) plc, the Foundation has enduring plans that goes beyond this to further support communities on an ongoing basis.

The Northern Powergrid Foundation is a grant-making charity that helps communities in our region become more resilient to energy changes. So far, we've supported over 90 communities to create warm and safe spaces for residents. The projects not only strengthen community resilience but also promote greener energy. This includes installing solar panels and battery storage. The Foundation believes in the power of community. That's why funding and support is provided to help people adapt to environmental, economic and societal changes in the energy sector.

The Northern Powergrid Foundation have ambitious plans to launch a range of projects and funding which on the following three key pillars:

- Energy Resilience
- Net Zero Networks
- Fuel Poverty

The Northern Powergrid Foundation Energy Resilience Fund has so far distributed over £1.3million to charities, not-for-profit organisations, and community groups who are taking a proactive approach to

support their community with energy resilience measures. These measures are designed to support communities during severe weather events and provide a place of shelter and support. The measures also help to reduce energy costs within a facility which enables greater investment into the activities and level of support available to the community.

Upon completion of your project, we like to complete a site visit which will involve photography of a cheque presentation to yourselves and other members of your community. We ask that you check with anyone who may appear in a photograph that they understand that their image may be used and that they consent to this. We also ask that you get in touch if there are any images you do not wish us to use. Anyone under the age of 18 who may be photographed will need to have parental consent prior to photography taking place.

Other Hints and Tips:

- Always refer to us as '*the Northern Powergrid Foundation*'.
- Ensure all your funders are thanked – it is nice to recognise everyone who has supported you with a project.
- Don't be afraid to shout about how great your project is and the impact it's had – No need to be modest – You've done something special in achieving grant funding and supporting your community!
- Document the projects journey from start to finish with photographs where possible.

- Include quotes from the local community in any communications – Highlight the positive impact your project has had.
- Reach out if you need any help – the Northern Powergrid Foundation team are always on hand to support and offer guidance wherever possible.
